CODE OF CONDUCT AGREEMENT FOR PLAYERS

Obligations towards the game

1. Make every effort to develop their own sporting abilities, in terms of skill, technique, tactics and stamina.
2. Give maximum effort and strive for the best possible performance during a game, even if his team is in a position where the desired result has already been achieved.
3. Set a positive example for others, particularly young players and supporters.
4. Avoid all forms of gamesmanship and time-wasting.
5. Always have regard for the best interests of the game, including where publicly expressing an opinion on the game and any particular aspect of it, including others involved in the game.
6. Not use inappropriate language.

Obligations towards one's own team

1. Make every effort consistent with Fair Play and the Laws of the Game to help his own team win.
2. Resist any influence, which might, or might be seen to, bring into question his commitment to the team winning.

Respect for the Laws of the Game and competition rules

1. Know and abide by the Laws, rules and spirit of the game, and the competition rules.
2. Accept success and failure, victory and defeat, equally.

3. Resist any temptation to take banned substances or use banned techniques.

Respect towards Opponents

1. Treat opponents with due respect at all times, irrespective of the result of the game.
2. Safeguard the physical fitness of opponents, avoid violence and roughplay, and help injured opponents.
3. Shake hands with the other team at the end of the game, no matter what the result is.

Respect towards the Match Officials

1. Accept the decision of the Match Official without protest.
2. Avoid words or actions which may mislead a Match Official.
3. Show due respect towards Match Officials.

Respect towards Team Officials

1. Abide by the instructions of their Coach and Team Officials, provided they do not contradict the spirit of this Code.

- Applaud good play – by either team.
- Not to argue with the referee and or any of the officials.
- Not to question the referees and or any of the officials decisions
- Remember the referee and officials are giving up their spare time to officiate the games, when was the last time you volunteered to referee a game!
- Stay off the field of play and not to interfere during the game.
- Let the referee and or the officials deal with any incidents and or situations during and after the game.
- Not to coach from the side-lines or shout at any child if they make a mistake.
- Not to use foul or abusive language towards any players, officials or any other spectators.
- Enjoy watching the game whether your team win or lose.
 - Ensure my child is prompt at training and games and does not hold these up because of lateness.
 - Ensure you contact your coach/manager in plenty of time if
 - Ensure you child is collected promptly from training and or the player is not available for games and or training.
 - games, do not leave the coach/manager to decide he/she has to bring them home or wait.
- **Do not leave your child at training sessions and or games until the manager/coach are present. The club is not responsible for the players until they (coach/manager) arrive for the session.**
